




The artist Leila Raabe aka “Edda” uses pigments and fabrics of everyday use in her paintings, sculptures and installations.

These works are thus not only visually and haptically perceptible, but also at an olfactory level. In a world full of images, Edda’s art is characterized by its tangibility and the individual physical perception of the viewer. The substance of the materials moves into the centre of her artistic position. Thus every authenticity of the spices, salts or sand, are portrayed as pure material.


The traditional use of conventional painting materials is not sufficient for her representations. She must be able to reach the works, to observe the details of the powdery surfaces, the coarse surface structures and the variation of the colours from close proximity, in order to be able to warn of the elaborated scenic effects of the paintings. Often gathering the materials, herself - on the spot - in different parts of the world.

Her expertise and use of these particular materials also bridge her heritage with her artistic vision. Born in Casablanca , Marocco and schooled in Germany (Edda is a Masterclass graduate of the Universität der Künste, Berlin), she surrogates the sensory richness of the bazaars , with the monochrome beauty of deserts, or the ocean.

In this way, her art combines modern minimalism with unique sensory opulence, that radiates serenity and a distinctively natural aesthetic.






















„Rug tattoo galore“


